## Topic: Snugglies (stuffed friends)

Language Arts: This week we will introduce "Teddy Bear", along with several fingerplays such as "Did you Ever See a Snuggly?" and "I have a Snuggly". The children will also enjoy using rhythm sticks as we practice using our listening ears. The picture file will help us sort snugglies vs. non-snugglies as well as reinforce our new shapes circle and square. We will look at different books about our new shapes.



Concept: The children have many new shelf jobs to use, some that include circles and squares and some that reinforce the colors red and blue. Big and small will be introduced as the children sort big and small snugglies. This week Ms. Cheryl will introduce the science table. The children can bring in things from outside such as leaves or rocks to display on the table.
