INTRODUCING: Ee, Ff

LANGUAGE:

Fall is here and we have so much to discuss. For the next 2 weeks, the children will learn about the season of fall. We have songs to sing and books to read. The letters Ee and Ff will be introduced along with their phonetic sounds and words that begin with it.

We have a new Fable to read; *The Hare and The Tortoise*

Lastly, we will introduce a reading story. The words to this story are: *Run, run, Taffy, Apple.*

CONCEPT:

We are going to introduce the seasons bin (feel free to bring in fall items you find). We have apple graphing and a science project to enjoy. We will also work on our art skills as we build a scarecrow and work on other Fall projects. We use different materials to strengthen the children’s little hands.
