Language:

We will also introduce the letters Cc and Dd and the phonetic sounds they make. If you have any nursery rhyme books that you would like to share, please bring them in to share.

Craft & Writing:

Over the next two weeks we will be working on papers to introduce the numbers 3 & 4 and letters Cc & Dd. We will also be practicing our scissor skills and we will be coloring and painting papers that will reinforce our theme. For some sensory and fine motor fun we will be playing with shaving cream and play-doh.

Concept:

The letters Cc and Dd and the numbers 3 and 4 will be added to the shelves for the children to work on. The children will learn about tally marks to graph things and we will also work on positional words like in, out, under, above and behind. We will also work on estimation activity, we will put things in order if size and we will do a Humpty Dumpty experiment. All these concepts and introductions will be worked on for the next 2 weeks.

Motor:

While outside, the children will enjoy rolling down the hill like Jack and Jill along with having a Humpty Dumpty race. As we plan to go outside for several activities this week, please be sure your child has the appropriate clothing and shoes for the up-coming weather. The kids will also be working on their balancing skills as the walk across the balance beam, the ball and wand will be used for eye hand coordination and their listening skills will be worked on with following directions activities like Simon Says and music with instruments.
