Theme: A Trip To The Zoo

Week of September 9

Introduce: Aa

Language Arts: Our picture file will be filled with all kinds of zoo animals. We will learn some new flannel board stories; "Going To the Zoo" and "The Zoo Visit." We will also learn new finger plays and a listening activity. The letter Aa will be introduced and the song A is for Amos.
