Language Arts: For the next two weeks we will have fun with flannel board stories and finger plays such as “Mary Had a Little Lamb,” “Little Miss Muffet,” “This Little Piggy,” and “Hey Diddle Diddle.” Our picture file will be based on our favorite Nursery Rhymes. The children will continue to go over Aa and our A is for Amos song. We will introduce the colors green and yellow, 1 and 2. We’ll learn a new listening activity about a mouse and a clock using our rhythm sticks.

Motor: We will continue to go outside, play our following direction game, use our push toys, and an obstacle course. We’ll have fun playing a tossing game using different sized balls and buckets. We’ll also play Ring Around The Rosie and dance to I’m A Little Teapot.
