Dinosaurs and Paleontologists

INTRODUCING:

Kk, Ll, Mm, Nn, Oo, Pp, 15,16,17, 18, 19, 20

LANGUAGE AND READING:

Over the next 2 weeks, we will be going back in time to learn all about dinosaurs. The children will enjoy plenty of songs and stories, and learn what it takes to be a paleontologist.

The letters Kk—Pp along with their phonetic sounds will be introduced. Word families “op” & “it” will also be introduced. We will make and sound out words with these letters in them.

CONCEPT:

The numbers 15—20 will be introduced. We will add these numbers to the shelf jobs and count by 5’s and 10’s. The geometric shapes cube, cylinder, cone and sphere will be reviewed.

With the change of season coming, we will discuss each season and the characteristics of that season.

CRAFT AND WRITING:

The boys and girls will have a lot of fun these next two weeks creating plenty of dinosaur crafts. We may even make our own fossils.

We will continue writing our names and letters Aa—Pp, and numbers 1-20.
