INTRODUCING: yellow & green

LANGUAGE:

"Autumn leaves are falling down, falling down, falling down. Autumn leaves are falling down, let's say hello to Autumn!" The season of Autumn is here! We can't wait to explore the seasonal changes. Our class will be introduced to the colors yellow and green. We will discuss leaves, pumpkins and acorns! We have many songs to sing about Autumn. Get ready to sing and dance with us!

CONCEPT:

We are going to explore outdoors with a nature walk. The children will help find Fall items (feel free to bring in any fall items you find at home for our seasons bin). We are adding new "jobs" to the Concept shelves. The colors yellow and green will be added to our color jobs. The children will each take turns squeezing and pouring at the water table. Lastly, we will do an apple graphing activity and an apple experiment.
