Dinosaurs

INTRODUCING: Gg, Hh

LANGUAGE AND READING:

For the next 2 weeks in language, the children will be busy learning about Dinosaurs. Many dinosaur stories will be read and we will learn some new vocabulary.

Two more manners will be added the “Bee Hive of Manners”: Eat with a spoon or a fork and talk with an empty mouth.

The children will learn the Fable; The Lion and the Mouse.

Letters Gg and Hh along with their phonetic sounds and words that begin with them will be introduced.

CONCEPT:

There is so much to do in concept this week with Dinosaurs! The children will become Paleontologists and watch a volcano erupt, measure their feet compared to a dinosaur’s foot and distinguish meat eaters from plant eaters! We will sort, measure, estimate and graph all that we learn. We will also get to carefully discover fossils.

The letters Gg and Hh will be added to the shelves and we will learn new jobs. Every day we count to 100 and sing the days of the week and months of the year.

CRAFT AND WRITING:

We will continue to work on our printing skills as the children write the letters Gg and Hh. We always start our printing from the top! We will complete the assessment paperwork as well.

We will make fossils, dinosaur masks, name-saurus dinos and a volcano blow art project. There will be many exciting projects coming home!

We will have some special projects done for Johnny Appleseed Day.
