Bobbie Noonan's will be celebrating giving thanks through this month. Take time to read below to see what is going on during the Month of November.

Preschool Drop off: Preschool drop off begins at 8:45 AM and ends at 9:00 AM. Please arrive between those times to be sure your child is included in all morning activities. Parents using the car drop off line, please stay in your car, and a teacher will walk your child in to school. At pick up time, please pull on to the street before buckling your child, and have your car name sign in the window. If you choose to walk your child into school, please park in a parking space, or on the street. Traffic will flow best with these procedures. Thank you!

Outside Play: Since the weather is getting colder, please remember to label all of your child's outerwear clearly with your child's name. This includes hats, gloves, scarves, and mittens. Daycare children will go outside everyday as long as it is not raining, and the temperature is above 20 degrees with the wind chill. All children will go outside even if proper attire is not brought to school. If you feel that your child is too sick to go outside, please keep them home. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.
