Language Arts:

The letters Mm , Nn, Oo, and Pp, will be introduced and added to our phonics board review. Over the next 3 weeks, we will be discussing the Native Americans and the First Thanksgiving. The children will learn who the Native Americans are, and what they did. The boys and girls will also get to discuss what they would like to serve for Thanksgiving dinner, and share what they are thankful for, to honor our upcoming holiday. The class will enjoy a variety of flannel board stories. We will be working on what we are thankful for, and our favorite Thanksgiving foods. Each child will be given a Native American name to be called for the next few weeks.
