**Language Arts:** These weeks ahead your little ghosts and goblins will be learning about Halloween and safety. We will start our week by learning some safety rules for home and school including “Dial 911” and “Stop, Look and Listen.” These are finger plays that help us remember what to do to stay safe. The next week we will be hearing Halloween tales such as *The Haunted House That Jack Built* and *Haunted House Haunted Mouse*.



**Concept:** Halloween is fast approaching and what fun we will have in our concept class. We will be learning about safety and about sorting and patterning. We have a lot of fun in our water table and going on a ghost hunt. And don't forget watching the seasons change. The concepts “heavy” and “light” will be introduced as well as adding more colors and numbers to our review.

**Craft & Writing:** For the next 2 weeks we will be talking about safety and Halloween. The children will learn what the traffic lights mean enjoy making a traffic light and stop sign. Triangle and rectangle shapes will be introduced to the children. We'll also work on Halloween art projects.
