## Craft and Writing

This week, the children will work on phonics papers and practice printing/tracing our new letters. They will learn about the different body parts of bats and spiders by labeling them and creating a booklet about them.

## Math & Science

In Math, the children will learn about the geometric shapes *rectangular prism*, and *triangular prism*.
