Craft and Writing

We will make a "What's Inside" a pumpkin craft and create a book about "Me on the Map."

Math & Science

The children have been rote counting from 1 to 100, and counting by 2's, 5's, 10's during calendar time. The Kindergarten State Bank will be introduced and will become part of our review each day. The children will learn how to add numbers up to 5 by using manipulatives.

In Science class, the children will be learning about the life cycle of a pumpkin and explore what is inside and outside of a pumpkin. We will discuss some interesting facts about our state, including the state bird, flower and fish.
