#### **Language Arts**

This week, we continue our exciting exploration of the Transportation theme! In addition to working on letters and word families, we will dive into new math, science, and social studies topics. We will practice recognizing and writing the letters O and P. At home, you can help by asking your child to find objects that begin with these letters, such as Oven, Ostrich, Pencil, and Parrot! This week, we're focusing on the -ED word family. We will be sounding out and spelling words like bed, red, sled, and fed. Ask your child to find -ED words in their books or around the house!

### Math / Science

In math, we are learning to count using tally marks! This is a fun way to track and group numbers in sets of five. We will be counting different objects and making tally marks on the board. You can help by practicing tally marks at home with toys or snacks. In science, we are learning about simple machines like levers, and pulleys. These tools make work easier, and we will explore how they help us in everyday life. We will be adding shelf jobs that explore building our own simple machines. This week in social studies, we will begin learning about Our Country, the USA. We will discuss the American flag and important national symbols. We will also learn about the different states in our country and the significance of national holidays like the Fourth of July.
