
Story 4 Vocabulary: See, Me


Concept: As we approach one of our favorite holidays, Halloween, our safety theme continues and we will explore the meaning of *Stranger Danger*. Numbers 11 and 12 are introduced. To enhance our fine motor skills, the children will use tweezers to pick pumpkin seeds from a bowl.

Language Arts: Now that we've talked about our safety rules and safety helpers, we will help the children understand who strangers are.. This weeks highlighted books are "Never Talk to Stragers" by Irma Joyce, and "Where are You?" by Francesca Simon., and a board book called "Safe at Play." We will discuss Safe vs Not Safe and continue singing Halloween and Fall themed songs.
