Topic: Safety & Fire



## Concept

We will measure distance using footsteps this week. First, they will estimate how many steps they think they will take going from the shelf to the wall, then see how close they came to the number.

A game of What's Missing? will help to sharpen the children's visual memory skills.

For science, we will grow a sweet potato plant! We will track the changes each week.

## Language Arts

Letters Kk and Ll will be introduced this week.

Fire safety pictures will "spark" our conversation.

Our daily phonics board will now include the letters A-L and we will have a fire fighter review.
