Forest Animals

Introducing: 7 and 8 Manners 5 & 6: Talk with an Empty Mouth & Eat with your Spoon or Fork

LANGUAGE AND READING:

This week we are going to learn all about what a forest is and what types of animals live in a forest. Some of the animals we will discuss are: foxes, owls, deer and skunks. We have many new vocabulary words to learn with this topic (nocturnal, forest, hibernate). We will play BINGO using cards with animals.

We will discuss our new manners, go over our letters and sounds and continue to practice stories with Taffy Apple.

CONCEPT:

We are going to learn about where forest animals live and what they eat in the forest through various activities. We have an indoor animal hunt to experience to see what animals we find. The children are going to track animals by their foot prints. We will see what prints belong to what animal. Lastly, the numbers 7 & 8 will be added to the shelf jobs.

CRAFT AND WRITING:

During craft and writing time the children work on strengthening their fine motor skills. We have some cute projects planned. Watch for some forest animals to come home the next two weeks. We will work on a skunk, hedgehog, bear, owl and squirrel.
