Review: Letters Aa–Zz
Numbers 1–20

LANGUAGE AND READING:

These next 2 weeks are going to be spent reviewing all of the letters from the alphabet and their phonetic sounds. We will introduce some new sight words: all, fall, how, now, six, are, boy, for, last, put. We will read some pumpkin books. The children will learn about the setting, author and the illustrator of a book. We will also read books and sing songs that pertain to Halloween. Lastly, our reading stories will be done.

CONCEPT:

We have many science projects and activities to be done dealing with pumpkins. We will learn the parts of a pumpkin and carve a jack o lantern. The numbers 1–20 will be reviewed as the children work with the jobs from the concept shelves. We will practice matching number words to the correct numeral. Simple addition will also be reinforced.

CRAFT AND WRITING:

There are many art and craft projects to do for the next two weeks for Halloween. The children will even get to paint their own pumpkin!

During writing, the children will practice printing all the letters of the alphabet correctly. They will also get to write about their Halloween costumes.

On October 31 we will celebrate Halloween with a party and Trunk or Treat! We are looking forward to this fun day!
