C-V-C Words (consonant—vowel—consonant)

LANGUAGE AND READING:

Your children have been working hard at learning all their letters and sounds. I am so proud of them. Now that they know the sounds of the letters it is time to start CVC words. CVC words are simple 3 letter words. We are going to build and sound out these words. We will also continue to practice sight words.

The weekly topic is weather. We have many fun weather songs to sing. The children are also going to learn new weather words and we will discuss our favorite type of weather.

CONCEPT:

The children are enjoying and becoming quite proficient with addition skills. Feel free to test them at home for fun! We will work on jobs off the shelf. Some of the jobs will be: article of clothing matching to the type of weather and the season's bin.

Science time will be filled with many weather experiments. We may even learn the different types of cloud names!
