Introducing: ones, tens, simple addition

LANGUAGE AND READING:

We are moving into the 9th week of school with so much to learn. We will be busy for the next two weeks of school as the children progress on their reading. We will continue to practice the sight words and Bold Beginning stories we have learned so far. We will discuss police and fire safety, stranger danger and dialing 911. We will also role play manners as we prepare to trick or treat.

CONCEPT/MATH/ SCIENCE:

The children are going to work on matching number words to the correct numeral. Simple addition will be reinforced during math, along with practicing place value. The children will practice recognition of 3-D shapes.

We will continue to look for signs of Fall and practice memorizing the four seasons.

We work off the concept shelves daily. The boys and girls are getting good with their jobs.

CRAFT AND WRITING:

Many readiness papers will be completed that reinforce phonetic sounds and proper printing.

During art and craft time, the children will complete a fire truck craft. In addition, they will also get to work on fall and Halloween projects for the month of October.
