INTRODUCING: Bb, orange, black

LANGUAGE:

Halloween is just about here! The children will have a spooktacular time reading, singing and learning about Halloween. We have flannel board stories and pictures to look at to enhance the topic. The letter Bb will also be introduced. We will learn what sound it makes, words that start with it and add it to our phonics song.

CONCEPT:
