Sensory play will provide a squishy new experience as we explore pumpkin guts. We will strengthen our fine motor skills with a glue bottle squeezing activity as we decorate pumpkins in a unique way for our classroom.

The color orange will be introduced and the children are going to love our new orange bin as well as finger painting with our new color. We will review all concepts that have been introduced during morning circle time with an active "High Five" and "Flip It" game.
