Language Arts

Many of the old favorite folk tales will be told such as "Goldilocks and the Three Bears", "Three Billy Goats Gruff" and "The Gingerbread Boy". These stories will be told using books and flannel board stories. We will also compare different versions of folk tales such as "The Gingerbread Girl". Sequencing of events from the folk tales will also add to the fun.



Concept

Triangles and rectangles will be added to our concept shelves for the children to sort. We will use our colored bears to introduce 2 types of patterns, an A,B pattern and an A,B,C pattern. For our science experiment we will begin to grow a sweet potato plant. This will allow the children to see the growth of both roots and leaves. You are welcome to bring in any fall items that we can explore at our science table. (gourds, pumpkins, corn etc.)

Motor

It's a review week! Activities previously introduced include the ball and wand, following directions games and balance beam activities. During ball play the children will have a chance to shoot baskets and kick a ball at a target.
