Language:
We will continue to work on story #1 “Run Taffy Apple”. We will be introducing the kids to the letter li and Jj along with the sounds they make. We will be talking about the first Thanksgiving, how we celebrate and what we are thankful for. Thanksgiving books are welcome, please remember to label it with your child’s name.

Craft & Writing:

The children will be making turkey headbands. Papers will be worked on to introduce the letters Ii and Jj, the colors yellow and green, as well as the numbers 9 and 10. The children will also be working on their fine motor with scissor skills and tracing papers.

Concept:

The children will continue to work on their numbers and counting over the next 2 weeks and they will also work on theme related jobs. The children will work on a group activity called "What's Missing" and they will play a Thanksgiving matching game.

Motor:

The children will be doing a following direction game and they will learn some kids' yoga. The kids will be moving their bodies with a pumpkin balancing activity, a race to fill game, a body movement game using dice and they will be doing a physical fitness test!
