Language Arts

This week, we're focusing on the letters W and X. Students will practice writing these letters and identifying words that start with them, like water, wagon, window, and x-ray! Our word family for the week is -IN. We'll explore words like pin, win, fin, tin, and spin. Encourage your child to look for -IN words at home or in books to reinforce this sound pattern. Our study of Native American culture continues! This week, we'll discuss traditional homes, food, clothing, and art forms while exploring their stories and legends. We will continue focusing on the themes of respect for nature and honoring the Earth.

Math / Science

In math, we're introducing measurement by comparing the lengths, heights, and sizes of objects around the classroom. In science, we'll explore the three states of matter: solid, liquid, and gas. Students will have hands-on activities to see how water can be ice, liquid, and even steam! We'll wrap up our discussions about the world by reviewing the continents and oceans.
