**Concept:** We have many fun Christmas activities planned for the next three weeks. One of our main areas of concentration will be numbers and estimation. We will also continue to work on compare and contrast using a sock and a Christmas stocking as well as a winter hat and Santa hat. A listening activity "What did you hear" will be introduced. I will have the children listen to three or four different sounds. Then they will close their eyes as I repeat one of the sounds and guess which one they hear. **Craft & Writing:** Over the next few weeks we will be introducing the letters Oo, Pp, shapes star and pentagon, as well as the numbers 11 and 12. We will be making some festive projects and cooking some delicious snacks as we travel around the world. The children will begin to work on a very special holiday project. It will arrive home in time for Christmas!
