LANGUAGE AND READING:

There is so much to be curious about as we discuss the change of season to Winter. What is it? How do we know it's Winter? What can we do in the Winter? Our little learners will enjoy songs, books and plenty of pictures about this theme.

The letters Kk and Ll will be introduced along with their phonetic sounds. We will add these letters to the "A is for Amos" song.

CONCEPT:

Did you know that all snowflakes have 6 sides but no two snowflakes are alike? This is one of the many fun facts we will learn about. We will also discuss hibernation and learn about winter being the coldest season. The children will get to sort, count and compare a variety of winter items.

We will add winter sensory bins and the letters Kk, Ll, oval and diamond jobs to the shelves.

CRAFT AND WRITING:

Our artists will be busy this week as we have many activities planned. Watch for snowmen and snowflake crafts to come home, along with other winter creations. We will also work on some readiness papers to reinforce the letters Kk and Ll and oval and diamond. We will also use the colors brown and purple. During craft and writing, we work on strengthening our hands and fingers. We do this through a variety of activities such as play doh and scissors.
