INTRODUCING: Ss, Tt, 17, 18 Story 4: See, me, run, and, jump Fable: Greedy Fox Proverb: Practice Makes Progress Manners: Do not point at people/Pick up after yourself			
LANGUAGE: During Language, the children will continue to review the letters and phonetic sounds that we have learned so far this school year. Story #4 will be introduced. The proverb, Practice Makes Progress and the fable, The Greedy Fox will be discussed. Our topic for the next 2 weeks is winter and arctic animals. We are going to learn many fun facts about both of these subjects. Books, flannel boards, fingerplays and games will help enhance the subjects. Hibernation, penguins, polar bears and snow will be our main focus.	CONCEPT: We will definitely be discussing the change of season this week in Concept. We will add jobs to the shelves about winter and arctic animals. The children will estimate how many snowflakes are in the jar. In science, the children will have fun making a snowstorm in a jar. We will discuss how ice is made and may even bring in snow to play with. Ss, Tt, 17 and 18 will be added to the shelf jobs.	CRAFT AND WRITING: We will work on readiness papers for the letters Ss & Tt and numbers 17 & 18. We are encouraging proper pencil grips and proper printing (starting each letter and number at the top). We are going to continue to trace and print our names (first and last).
