Weeks 22 and 23: January 13-24, 2025
Theme: Healthy Children

Language Arts:

We will be introducing the theme of healthy children through fun finger plays including: Good Exercise, Good Foods, and Night, Night Rhyme. The children will also see the stories Night Time, Healthy Habits, and Rise and Shine come to life on our flannel board. The children will also be viewing several surprise picture cards on health. We'll also enjoy the puppet play Healthy Habits, A-P-PL-E (red, yellow, or green), and the book Eating the Alphabet. Lastly, we will feed our Hungry Puppet healthy foods.

Concept:

After discussing healthy and unhealthy foods, the children will be sorting food into the categories healthy or unhealthy. We'll also discuss our favorite healthy foods. In addition, we will be working on shelf jobs to review all of the concepts introduced.

Motor:

The children will be using the wooden stairs and the rocking boat. The children will also get a chance to go bowling! We'll take note on how these indoor motor activities help to keep our bodies healthy. Our activities will also help us learn the words come and go.
