Craft & Writing

For the next two weeks, the children will make a penguin, polar bear and walrus craft. The children will also begin printing on lined paper.

Math & Science

The children will learn to tell time by the hour. They will also work on recognizing and making simple fractions, including $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{5}$, and $\frac{1}{6}$ and reviewing addition and greater and less than concepts.

Language Arts

The children will be introduced to "blends". A consonant blend is two or more letters that come together in a word. Their sounds blend together to make one sound. We will start with "L" blends, such as bl, cl, fl, gl, pl and sl.
