Language:

For the next two weeks we will be talking about transportation. The children will learn about the many different types of vehicles there are and what they are used for. The children may bring in any books, theme related to share with the class. The children will be introduced to story # 9 and will continue to work on the reading words of all the other stories introduced so far. The children will also be listening to flannel board stories and poems about our theme.

Craft & Writing:

Over the next two weeks, the children will be working on papers that focus on beginning letter sound, number ordinal and positional words. We will also work on letter matching, what's missing and papers to reinforce our new shapes octagon and trapezoid. Keep a look out for transportation art projects that will be done to reinforce our theme.

Concept:

The next two weeks we will start rote counting to 30. We will be working on compare and contrast activities, playing the game "what's missing", using our tactile bag and playing number bingo to help with our numbers. We will also begin to count by 5's and working on jobs to reinforce our new shapes octagon and trapezoid and our theme of transportation.
