LANGUAGE AND READING:

Our five senses help us experience and learn about the world we live in. Over the next 2 weeks, we will explore how we hear, taste, see, smell and touch. We have many books and other visuals to help us learn this topic including the book "Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What Do You See".
