INTRODUCING: counting by 10's

LANGUAGE:

We will start this week by learning about Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. We will discuss what a wonderful, loving man that he was and how he dreamed for us all to be fair and kind.

For the next 2 weeks we are going to discuss how to be healthy and what to do to be healthy. Some of the things that we will discuss are: bathroom hygiene, exercise, healthy foods, germs, doctors, dentists, nurses and hospitals. The children will get to role play and learn all about being healthy.

CONCEPT:

We will count by 10's every day for the next few weeks. We will also learn the Golden Beads (1's, 10's 100's).

We will have a graphing activity for the children to do. We are going to learn about Groundhog's day and predict (on 1/31) if we think the groundhog will see his shadow or not. We will then graph the results.

Lastly, the children will go off the Concept shelves and work on their jobs.

CRAFT AND WRITING:

Our scissor skills will be put to the test over the next 2 weeks. We are working hard to strengthen our fine motor skills by cutting on the line.

We will enjoy a craft project on healthy living by making a plate of healthy food. We have healthy body papers and we will see what a doctor's bag looks like.

As always, we will work on readiness papers and practice printing.
